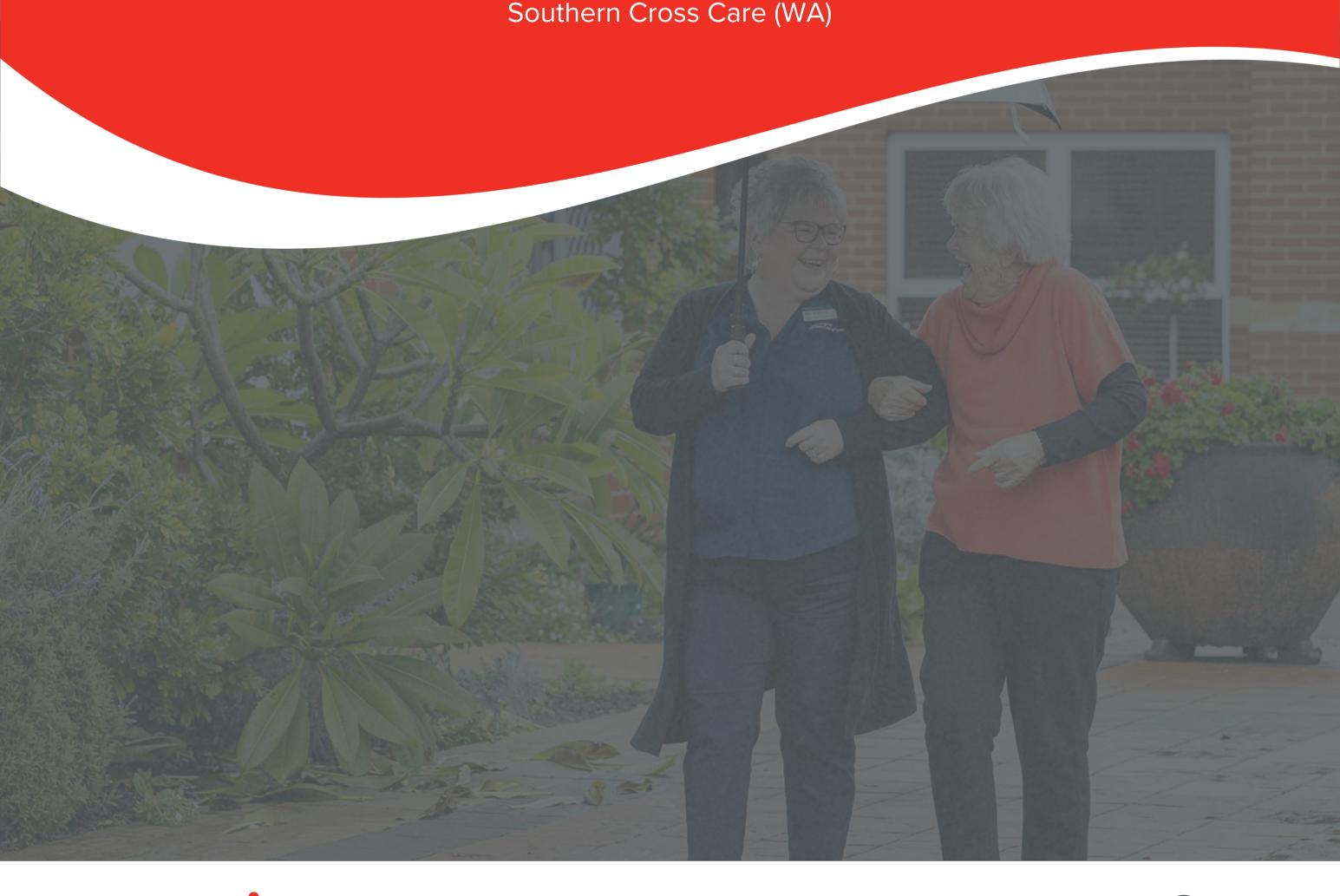
SCC (WA) initiated a rigorous selection process and Epicor's aged care-industry specific Kinetic Senior Living Solution (SLS) was chosen.
